(3) Actual disarmament of Partisans is a function of AMG to be performed in cooperation with Division Commanders. Military personnel other than AMG will not attempt to disarm Pertisans except in emergencies.

(4) Regimental Commanders are responsible for administration of Partisans used for operational purposes.

fo Blackout. Blackout regulations for German Troops and vehicles are suspended until further orders.

## go Control.

- (1) Fraternisation has been noted between American and German soldiers. This is prohibited.
- (2) More frequent U. S. parrols must operate between units within zones, of responsibility where German soldiers are known to be concentrated.
- (5) Except on official business, German troops quartered out of cities and towns will not be permitted entry therein. Circulation of troops quartered in cities and towns is permissable insofar as it does not interfere or obstruct maffic and conduct of official business. Curfew will be from 2030B to 0500B.


