


A. Original Unit

(1) Designation: Headquarters and Military Police Company.

(2) Date of Organization: 15 May 1942.

(3) Place of Organization: Camp Shelby, Miss.

(4) Authority for Organization: General Orders No. 1, Headquarters,

85th Infantry Division.

- (5) Sources from which personnel was obtained, i.e. by transfer from other units, voluntary enlistment or draft: original cadre of 38 enlisted men from 2d Infantry Division, Fort Sam Houston, Texas; 6 officers transferred from other organizations; balance of enlisted personnel consisting of voluntary enlistees and draftees obtained from various reception and induction centers throughout the country.

(1) Company was activated under Tables of Organization 7-1 and 7-2,

dated 1 April 1942, including change dated 10 April 1942.

(2) Company reorganized in June, 1942 under Tables of Organization 7-1 and 7-2, dated 1 June 1942.

- (3) Military Police Platoon reorganized in June, 1942 under Table of Organization 19-7, dated 1 April 1942.

(1) In March, 1943, Military Police Platoon was reorganized under Table of Organization 19-7 dated 1 March 1943, which superseded Table of

Organization 19-7 dated 1 April 1942.

- (2) 1 September 1943, Headquarters Company with attached Division Headquarters Platoon was reorganized under Tables of Organization and Equipment 7-1 and Tables of Organization and Equipment 7-2 dated 15 July 1943. At this time, Company became a component of Special Troops, 85th Infantry Division, under Tables of Organization and Equipment 7-3 dated 15 July 1943, with Military Police Platoon, Division Band, Headquarters Special Troops, Medical Detachment, Special Troops, and Attached Chaplain, Special Troops attached for rations, quarters, and administration. At close of 1943, unit still operating under the above.

#### L. SUMMARY

(1) 18 January 1945; moved out of base camp, Camp Shelby, Miss., 0700; arrived in biveuse area 0800.

(2) 25 January 1945; moved back to base camp 0715.

- (5) 6 February 1945; Maj Grover C Lewis (Company Commander) granted leave of absence; Capt Howard M Beisden assumed command as Company Commander and Headquarters Commandant.
- (4) 21 February 1943; Company moved into field to participate in D series Fifteenth Corps Maneuvers, Mississippi Maneuver Area.; station—Camp Shelby, Miss.

(5) 27 February 1945; Company moved back to Camp Shelby, Miss. for rest and to receive pay.

- (6) 1 March 1945; Company moved back into field to complete D series maneuvers.
- (7) 15 March 1945; D series maneuvers closed; forward echelon moved back to Camp Shelby, Miss.
- (8) 17 March 1945; Maj Grover C Lewis relieved from assignment and duty, authority, Letter, WD, Adjutant General School, dated 6 March 1945.
- (9) 20 March 1945; scheduled Division Review called off due to inclement weather.
- (10) 5 April 1943; main body of Company left Camp Shelby, Miss., 0900 by motor convey; arrived Natchez, Miss. bivouse area 1750.
- (11) 6 April 1945; Company left Natches bivouse area at 0845 and arrived at Louisiana Maneuver Area vicinity Lessville, La. 1850.
- (12) 11 April 6 June 1945; Com pany participated in 2d phase, Louisiana Third Army maneuvers against 95d Infantry Division.

(15) 6 June 1945; Company moved to Bon Wier, Texas bivouse area.

- (14) 6 June 1945; advance party left for new station, Camp Pilot Knob, DTC, Calif.
- (15) 9 June 1945; advance party detrained vicinity Yuma, Ariz., and motored to Camp Pilot Knob, Calif.
- (16) 9 June 1945: Maj Howard M Baisden relieved from assignment and duty as Company Commander and Headquarters Commandant, transferred to Fifteenth Corps. Captain Thomas A Roberts assumed command of company.
- (17) 25 June 1945; main body of Company arrived Camp Filot Knob, DTC, Calif. (18) 28 June 1945; Capt Thomas A Roberts appointed Headquarters Commandant.
- (19) 15 August 1945; left Camp Pilot Knob, DTC, Calif., 0950; traveled in tactical convoy to Camp Coxcomb, DTC, Calif., arrived 2100; distance, 190 miles; weather, very hot.

(20) 1 September 1943: Company became component of Special Troops, 85th Infantry Division; Capt Thomas A Roberts relieved of duties as Headquarters Commandant.

(21) 5 October 1943: departed Camp Coxcomb, DTC, Calif., 0900 by motor convoy enroute Freda Station, DTC, Calif.; entrained at Freda, Calif. 1300—destination, Fort Dix, N.J.; weather, cool.

(22) 7 October 1943: arrived Fort Dix, N.J. 1630; traveled by truck to company area.

(23) 8 October 1943-16 December 1943: Company furloughed; period apent in getting command P.O.M. qualified.

(24) 17 December 1943: left Fort Dix, N.J.; entrained 1940 for Camp Patrick Henry, Va.; weather, cold.

(25) 18 December 1943: arrived Camp Patrick Henry, Va. 1300.

(26) 19 December 1943-23 December 1943: period spent in staging operations.

(27) 24 December 1943; entrained Camp Patrick Henry, Va. 1135; arrived Newport News dock 1345; boarded U.S.S. Gen A.E. Anderson 1400; got underway 1530; weather, fair; sea, calm.

(28) 31 December 1943: at sea aboard U.SIS. A.E.Anderson; organization was at full Table of Organization strength as of this date; officers who accompanied Headquarters Company and attached units overseas:
