- 1 Feb: Forward echelon remained in bivouac area vicinity of Villa de Sassonero, Italy. Coordinates 965234, Loiano Sheet 98-1, Italy map 1:50,000.
 Rear echelon remained in bivouac area at Gagliano, Italy.Coordinates 831957, Firenzuola Sheet 98-11, Italy map 1:50,000.
- 1-5 Feb: Both echelons remained in same bivouac areas and performed regular duties.
- 6 Feb: Decoration ceremony held in forward echelon. General Truscott, 5th Army Commander and General Keys, II Corps Commander present for ceremony. No change in location of either forward or rear echelon.
- 7-10 Feb: Both echelons remained stationary and performed regular duty.
- 11-20 Feb: Both echelons remained stationary and perfored regular duty. Weather during this period mostly fair.
- 21 Feb: 85th Division Band moved to Montecatini, Italy for duty with the 85th Infantry Division rest center.
- 22-27 Feb: Forward and rear echelons remained in respective bivouac areas and performed regular duties.
- 28 Feb: Company paid.
