## REPORT OF OPERATIONS 1 November to 30 November 1944

1 - Nov: Forward echelon remained in bivouac at La Pozza, Italy. Coordinates 902209, Loiano Sheet 98-1, Italy map 1:50,000.

> Rear echelon remained in bivouac 1 mile S.E. Firenzuola, Italy. Coordinates L914060, Firenzuola Sheet 98-11, Italy map 1:50,000. Weather: Rain all day.

- 2-8 Nov: Both echelons remained in respective areas and carried on normal duties. Weather: Mostly overcast with considerable rain.
- Rear echelon moved from bivouac area 1 mile S. E. Firenzuola, Italy to 9 - Nov: Gagliano, Italy. Coordinates 831957, Firenzuola Sheet 98-11, Italy map L:50,000. Movement made in two convoys. Hq. Co. and Division Headquarters sections with part of Division unit personnel sections left old area at 0930 and arrived in Gagliano at 1130. Balance of unit personnel sections and 85th Division Band left old area 1455 and arrived in new area 1900. Weather very foggy with rain. Move completed without any accidents. Division Hq. Sections, Co. CP and Unit personnel housed in good buildings. Part of officers and most of enlisted personnel bivouaced in pryamidal and shelter tents.

Forward echelon remained at La Pozza, Italy.

- 10-19 Nov: Forward echelon remained in bivouac at La Pozza, Italy. Rear echelon remained in bivouac at Gagliano, Italy. During this period normal duties were performed by both echelons. Most of personnel in rear echelon were moved out of tents and billeted in buildings. Forward echelon made preparations to move back to rest area at Gagliano. Weather during period very changeable, being clear about half the time.
- Forward echelon sent an advance detachment of about 100 officers and enlisted men to new bivouac site vicinity of Gagliano, Italy. 20- Nov:

Rear echelon remained in bivouac at Gagliano, Italy.

Forward CP remained at La Pozza, Italy. Rear echelon and advance detachment from forward echelon remained in their respective bivouac areas at DECLASSIFIED CONFIDENTIAL

- 22 Nov: Forward echelon moved from bivouac area at La Pozza, Italy to bivouac area vicinity of Gagliano, Italy. Cordinates 824949, Firenzuola sheet 98-11, Italy map 1:50,000.

  Forward and rear echelons now located about three quarters of a mile apart. Forward echelon located in a villa SW Gagliano. Rear echelon located in Gagliano proper.
- 23-29 Nov: Forward and rear echelons remained in their respective areas and performed regular duties. Four day passes to Montecatini Rest Center were granted to a large number of Division Headquarters and Hq. Co. personnel. Four day passes to Rome and Florence, and one day passes to Florence were continued during this period.

  All enlisted personnel were checked for identification tags, pay books and names in boots or leggins. Deficiencies were corrected.
- 30 Nov: Forward echelon remained in bivouac vicinity of Gagliano, Italy.
  Coordinates 824949, Firenzuola Sheet 98-11, 1:50,000. Rear echelon
  remained in bivouac at Gagliano, Italy. Coordinates 831957, Firenzuola
  Sheet 98-11, map 1:50,000. Company was paid.

- Weether: The weather for November was generally overcast and rainy, although somewhat better than October. Transportation problems were improved due to the location of the CP. The short distance between echelons reduced the number of mecessary long trips.
- Strength: Loss of three officers and three enlisted men in Headquarters Company and attached units for month of November.
